

COVID Positive/ Quarantine Independent Study Contract

(5 days min. to 15 days max.)

A COVID Independent Study Contract (ISC) is available for a student who has symptoms of COVID, who has tested positive for COVID, or, who has a direct exposure to a COVID positive person and must quarantine for 14 days. (A student may test on the 5th day and return after the 7th day if the COVID test was negative and there are no symptoms.)

Why apply for a COVID ISC? When a student is absent for anything other than an illness/doctor's note, it is an unexcused absence. When a student has 3 or more unexcused absences, they are considered truant and will receive an attendance letter. To avoid this, a student may be out on an ISC for 5-15 school days and receive attendance credit when the work is completed and submitted. An ISC also helps a student keep up on the learning. The ISC work may not be exactly what is being taught while the student is out.

How to apply for a COVID ISC:

1. Contact the office when the direct exposure occurs or a positive test result is received to start the ISC.
 - a. The ISC contract can be signed after the quarantine is over.
2. Work will be provided in the school office, placed outside the office for pick up, or in the Google Classroom.
3. Complete ALL assignments while out.
4. Return all work to the school office upon return to school. If the student does not complete and return the work.
