


From Our Superintendent/Principal

As we head into the month of April, this is usually the time of year where we are preparing your child is doing academically and where we for our 3rd-8th grade students to take the state will need to provide additional support. Our staff CAASPP tests in ELA and math. At this time, we are waiting to hear if California's waiver will be approved. If approved, our students will not be required to take the assessment for this year. We will keep you posted. Assessments are a very important form of data which provides feedback to staff, students, and parents as to academic progress. Spring Grove continues to provide assessments on grade level standards though out the year. These include: reading and math assessments at the end of units or chapters, District writing assessments, Wordly Wise vocabulary assessments, i-Ready assessments, Orton Gillingham Assessments, CAASPP blocks, and several other formative

assessments. These help teachers to know how will also be planning for next year and interventions to support our students. It is our hope that we will be back in class full time in the 2021–2022 school year because CDC and the state of California have provided language that states children are to social distance 3 feet instead of 6 feet. This is great news for all of us. Please remind your children to follow the dress code found in the student/parent handbook as the weather begins to get warmer, a reminder that students may not use their cell phones while on campus. They are to be used after school and outside of the green gates. Thank you!
