During your summer vacation, we encourage your students to take time daily to read. The Summer Reading Log has been included. Students can go to the public library to check out books. It is important to read throughout the summer to help with fluency, accuracy, and comprehension. If your student has not yet mastered their math addition/subtraction facts (all grades) or multiplication/division facts (3rd-8th grade) practice these as well. Spend time talking with your child and let them do the talking about how they are feeling, what they did during the day etc. It is important that we put our cell phones down and just engage with our children.
